- 1) **RESOLVED: To approve the sale of a piece of property at 70 Scofield Hill Road to Edith Johnson.** **Motion:** To postpone this Agenda item indefinitely due to the need for more information. By Jim Brinton, seconded by Dean Sarjeant and unanimously approved.
- 2) **RESOLVED: To approve the ARPA Fund Committee recommendation of \$10,000 for Greenwoods Counseling.** By Jim Brinton, seconded by Mary Anne Greene. Discussion: Jim Brinton explained that this recommendation had been approved by the Board of Selectmen and the Board of Finance however, not at a Town Meeting. Sheila Anson commented that Greenwoods, who's office is in Litchfield, serves the Washington Community. The motion passed unanimously.
- 3) **RESOLVED: To approve the ARPA Fund Committee recommendation of \$25,000 for the Washington Scholarship Fund.** By Jim Brinton, seconded by Dean Sarjeant. Discussion: Jim Brinton explained that this amount would be the last to be approved as all the funds that had been allocated to the Town of Washington have now been awarded. Sheila Anson asked if the \$25,000 would be used for scholarships. Jim Brinton confirmed they would be. The motion passed unanimously.
